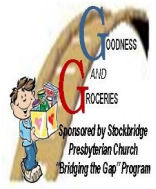

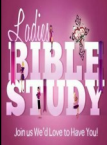

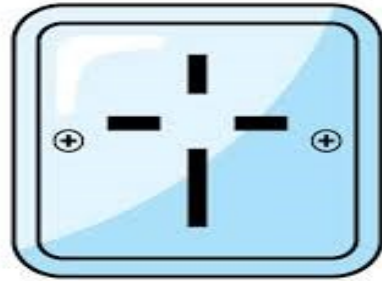
Dear Peggy and Prayer Partners,

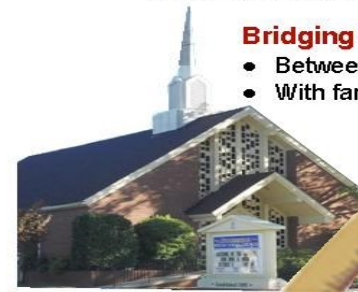

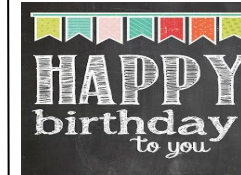
