It should really be a real treat!

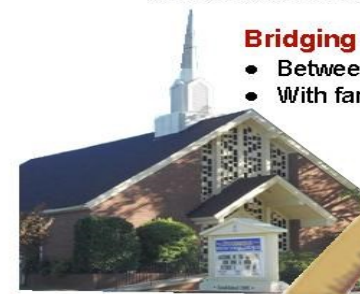
For 51 years they have been serving good food,

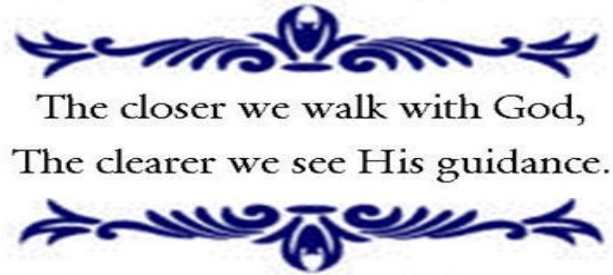
