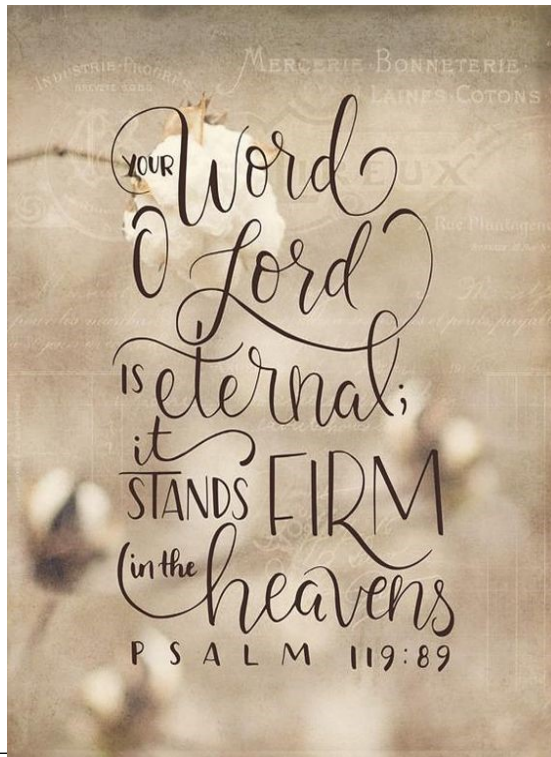


Goodness & Groceries Ministry

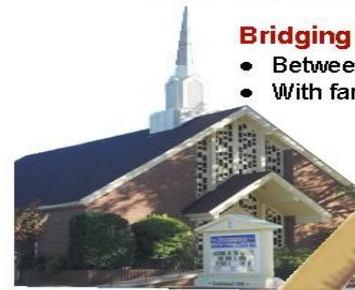

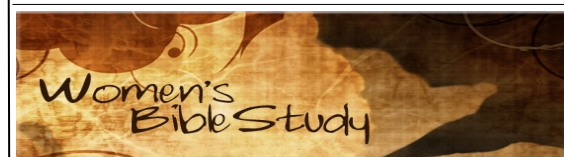
Fellowship
