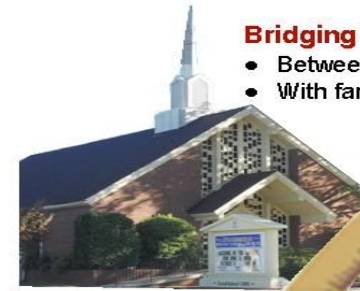

### BRIDGE FAMILY BASKET NEWS

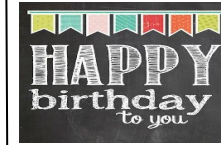
