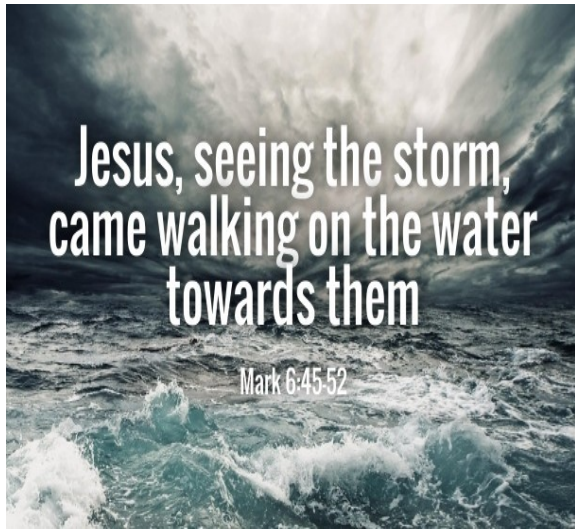




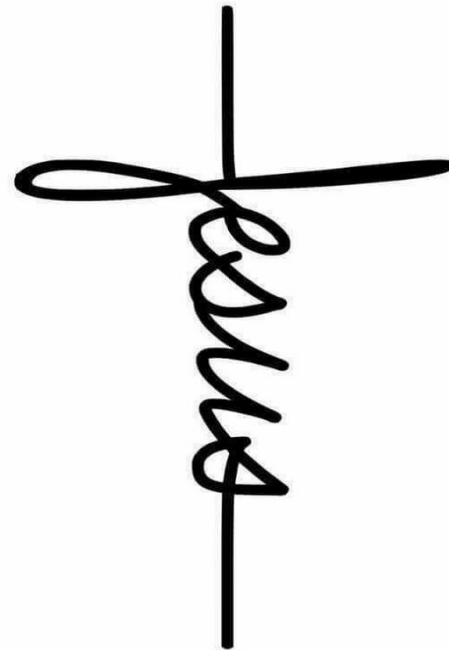
Per Capita Offering

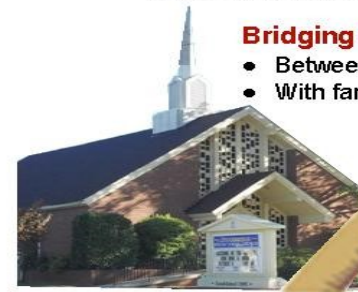

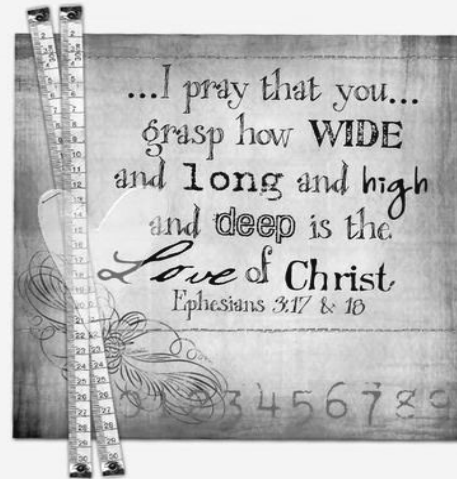

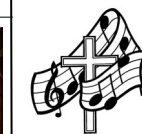
