Your concern and love for us is humbling and shows your love of God to us.

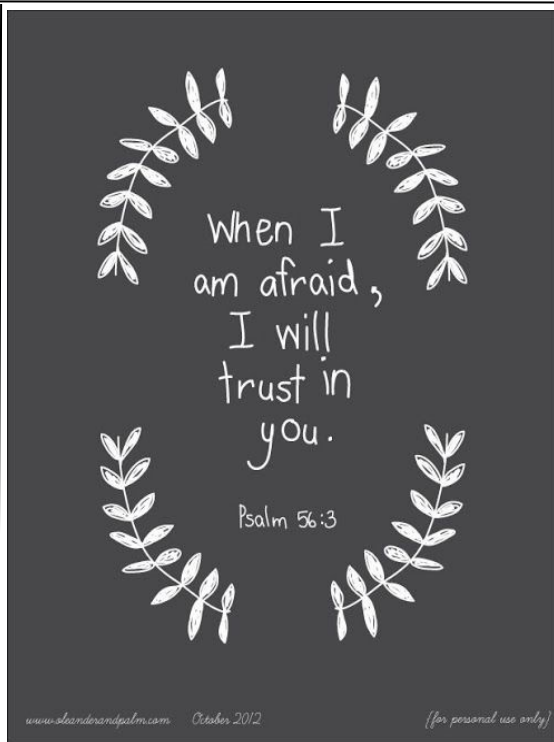

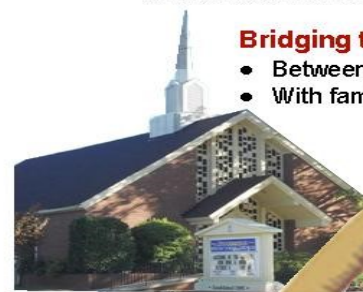

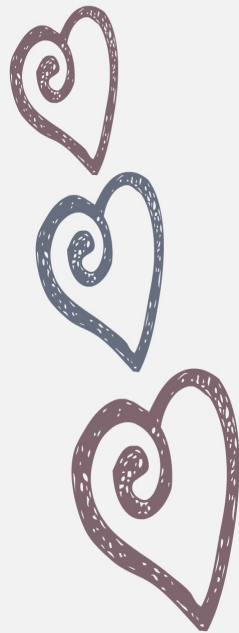
