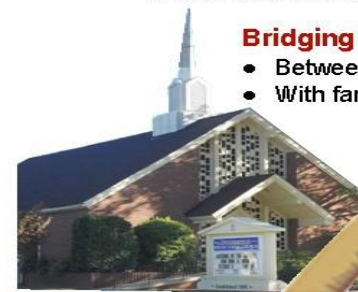

It is time to start cleaning out your closets, attics, and sheds to prepare for the yard sale. We are a little over a month away, so you have plenty of time to get your items together.

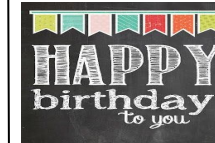
