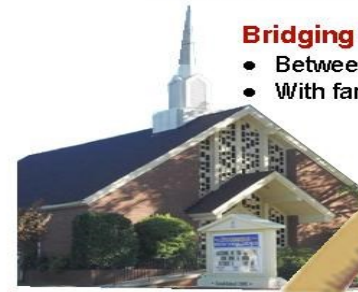

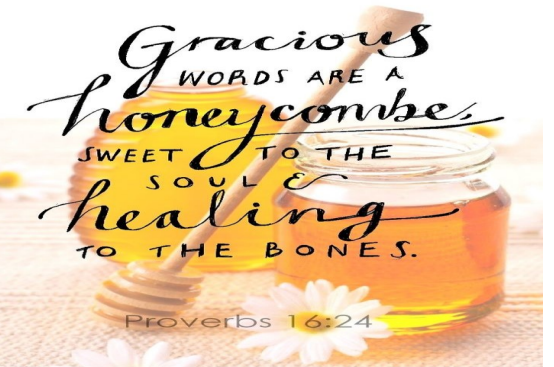
Goodness & Groceries Ministry
