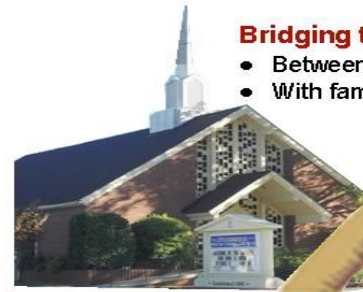
There's a meeting to which you need to go. We would like everyone to show. We want to entice you and whet your appetites, by having delicious food on the table, in plain sight!

We will not meet in December, but will resume Thursday, January 16, 2014. We would be happy to share in this good time with you. Come join us.

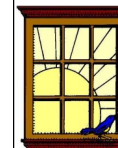


The Live Nativity December 14, 2013
