Please bring by Sunday, December 8, 2013

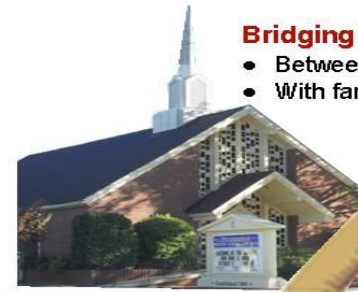
The tree stands there,
