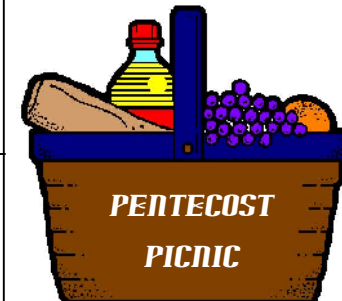
### VACATION BIBLE SCHOOL
