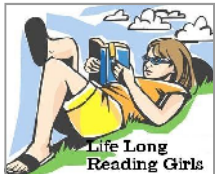

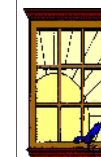
### VACATION BIBLE SCHOOL
