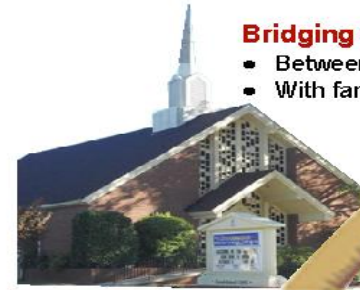

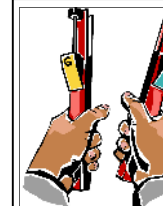

### RALLY DAY SEPT 9TH

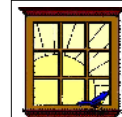
**NOTE DATE CHANGE!!** Be sure to plan to be here on **Rally Day!** Children will be promoted to new Sunday School classes as appropriate.
