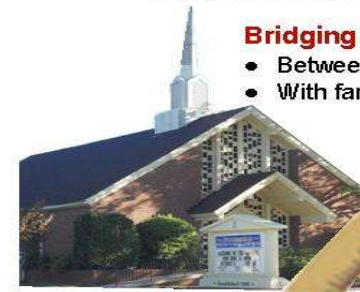

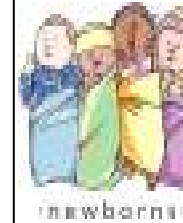


WANTED!! PICTURES FROM YOUR MILITARY SERVICE!!
