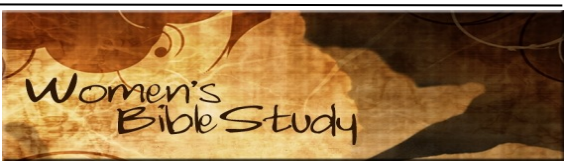


Do you know what your generous donations to the general fund are used for? Here are a few examples:
