Kristy reported on her activities with the Committee for Preparation for Ministry with the Presbytery. She also updated the Session on the health of several members.

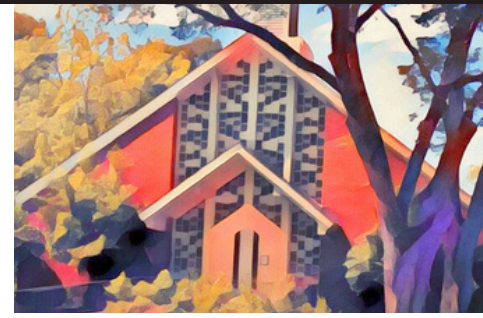
Old Business:
